Sign up to the 'HWA Environmental & Community Pledges' with a view to a continued progression to improve and develop organisational capability, as appropriate, in line with the pledge standards



Share information and assist one another in developing best practice through a diverse number of industries



Lead by example and reduce single use plastics in our individual workforces and through our supply chains



Develop sustained land and water-based projects (surveying, cleaning, monitoring) to assess and manage litter in the region through community action



Promote environmentally friendly and sustainable practices, including disposal and recycling, through social media community information, education opportunities and public engagement



Engage and partner with schemes and events of a similar nature in the area (such as the Hulltimate Challenge, Freedom Festival and Council initiatives) for promotion of our messages



Apply jointly for funding where appropriate to assist with waste reduction activities and initiatives



Develop a list of existing activities (such as beach cleans and litter picks) that organisations currently do and that could be advertised among members of the group for staff days



Aim to achieve a community award such as 'Plastic Free Communities', 'One Less City', 'Refill City' etc



Share data and produce a joint summary document at the end of each year detailing the impact of the HWA as evidence



Contribute (where appropriate) to a central seed fund by way of an annualised membership fee (of £to be determined) payable to the HWA on a per organisation, annual basis for those organisations able to make such a donation



Commit to attending a minimum of **4 out of 6** bi-monthly working group meetings per year, furthermore, ensuring an organisational representative is arranged to attend in members absence in instances where core member attendance is not possible
